Application Deadline: October 1, 2016

The Founder's Scholarship was established by the Board of Trustees of Trivium School to commemorate John & Louise Schmitt, the principal founders of Trivium School, and to award financial support to students who articulate the value of their education.

Applicants must be registered students at Trivium School. Essays are due in the Trivium Office on October 1, 2016. They are to be 2 to 3 pages, typed and double spaced in 12-point Times New Roman with a margin of 1 inch on all sides. On a cover sheet, applicants are to list their name, address, telephone number, email, grade, and age. The essays will be divided into three groups (7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grades, 9<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup> grades, and 11<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades) and the student with the most votes wins. The judges will be a panel of alumni and the awards will have no relation to other financial aid requests.
