# SAT Prep Course

March 23 to June 1

### The SAT tests students on their ability to:

Comprehend reading passages (inc. charts, tables, graphs)

Improve the quality of writing in passages

Write a cohesive, effective essay analyzing a reading selection and prompt

Solve math problems (with and without a calculator)

Problems are founded on concepts/skills learned in Algebra 1, Algebra 2, and Geometry, including trigonometric functions

### How important is it to achieve a high SAT score?

It is extremely important. A high SAT score opens up opportunities to get accepted at more and better colleges and universities, as well as opportunities to win college scholarships.

Ascertain what score your child needs for his or her target school. Go to [www.collegeboard.com](http://www.collegeboard.com) and do a search on each school. Click on "Applying" to see SAT and ACT score ranges. (Be aware that the reported SAT ranges are based on the old 2400 scoring system, while the new SAT is out of 1600).

### Why should my child take THIS course?

This program provides an unparalleled review of essential SAT content, including math topics, writing and grammar fundamentals, and reading strategies, as well as test-taking strategies and techniques.

Having completed this course, many diligent students earned SAT scores 150+ points above their PSAT. While no course can guarantee a specific level of achievement, the instruction and exercises in this program are comprehensive and methodical and were developed to help students reach their academic potentials.

The course is paced for students that achieved a 1050 or greater on the PSAT (or 23 on the PLAN). If students scored lower, they may find the in-class work particularly challenging and should be prepared to spend additional time working on the assignments.
